

General Membership Meeting Minutes

A meeting of the general membership of the Skyline High School PTSA was held on Monday, November 13, 2006, at Skyline High School.

The meeting was called to order by Co-President Kara Neary at 7:02. A quorum was present.

Mike Gallagher, Issaquah School District Executive Director of High Schools, was present to discuss the resignation of Principal Ed Young and the search for an interim principal and a more long-term principal at Skyline. Mike is working through a list of retire/rehire possibilities for the interim principal. In January, the District will post a job opening for the long-term principal. An interview team will be formed and will meet in January.

Jeff McGowan was present to reassure the membership that goals established at the beginning of the school year were still in effect and that leadership was present on the Skyline campus.

Kelly Munn delivered a presentation on Education Funding on behalf of the League of Education Voters.

President's Report

Kara Neary reported that the Skyline Site Council sought input from its stakeholders on the issue of communication between parents, teachers, and students. Discussion took place about various issues meeting attendees have experienced, or that their students have experienced, when dealing with teachers. The responses from the group were mixed-both positive and negative-and included an instance where retribution occurred against a student as a result of the parent discussing the issue with the teacher. A summary of the discussion is to be presented by Kara at the next Skyline Site Council meeting.

PTSA Committee Reports

Patti Holladay presented the choices researched for \$8018.52 of Mini Grants expenditures. See attached Exhibit "A." Suzie Wiley motioned that the items on the list be approved and Fanny Vasquez seconded. All in attendance were in favor.

Suzanne Weaver presented the monthly financial report for the period ending October 2006. She mentioned that revenue from the Mock ACT testing, membership, and the Pass the Hat fundraiser was reflected, and taxes, and directory and Legislative Assembly expenses had been paid. Suzie Wiley motioned to approve the minutes for the General Membership meeting held on October 9, 2006 as written. Heather Gillette seconded. All in attendance were in favor. See attached Exhibit "C".
